# The Holy Spirit

### **Introduction**

The Holy Spirit is NOT a third person in the Godhead as Trinitarians claim, but the only one true God Himself. If God is a spirit, then he cannot be an evil spirit but holy. Romans 8:9, John 4:23, 24 2Corinthians 3:17,Luke 1:35

The Holy Spirit is synonymous to Holy Ghost, and these two words are used interchangeably, **John 14:15-17 Acts 2:38** 

### What is Holy Spirit Baptism?

- 1. It is called the washing of regeneration- Titus 3:5
- 2. It is the infilling or indwelling of the spirit of God-<u>Ephesians 1:16-17,Acts 2:1-4,Luke</u> 24:44-48
- 3. It is part of the new birth process-John 3:3-5

### "why we need" the holy spirit

# A. promised by Jesus...

To all who believe in Him - Jn 7:37-39

### B. promised by peter...

To all who repent and are baptized - Ac 2:38-39

To those who obey God - Ac 5:32

### C. promised by Paul...

To those who become children of God - Ga 4:6; Ro 8:14-16

Indeed, one cannot be Christ's unless they have the Spirit dwelling in them - Ro 8:9

# II. because of the work of the Holy Spirit

# A. convicting the world...

Of sin, righteousness, and judgment - Jn 16:7-11

Done through the gospel of Christ

- a. The instrument designed to produce faith Ro 10:17
- b. Which is God's power to save Ro 1:16-17
- c. And determines who will be judged (condemned) 2Th 1:7-9

# Through the Word, the Spirit convicts the world of sin

# **B.** regenerating the sinner...

Saving those who respond through the washing of regeneration - <u>Tit 3:4-6</u>

- a. Being born again of water and the Spirit Jn 3:5
- b. In which one's sins are washed away by the blood of Christ
  - Ac 22:16; Ep 1:7

Causing them to be reborn, in conjunction with the Word - 1 Pe 1:22-23,25

### When one obeys the Word, the Spirit regenerates the sinner

### C. sanctifying the saved...

A process that begins when washed and justified - 1Co 6:11

- 2. A process that continues with the aid of the Word
  - a. We are sanctified by God's Word Jn 17:17
  - b. Which is the sword of the Spirit **Ep 6:17**
  - -- When one abides in the Word, the Spirit sanctifies the believer

### III. because of the blessings of the Holy Spirit

### A. the indwelling of the spirit...

Indwelling the Christian - Ro 8:9-11; cf. 1Co 6:19

Enabling us to put to death the deeds of the body - Ro 8:12-13

Strengthening us in the inner man - Ep 3:16,20; cf. Php 2:12-13

The Spirit is the Father's instrument to empower the Christian

B. the seal of the spirit...

A seal marking us as belonging to God - **Ep 1:13** 

Looking forward to the day of our redemption - Ep 4:30

-- The Spirit is the Father's identifier that we belong to Him

C. the earnest of the spirit...

A guarantee or down payment of our inheritance - Ep 1:13-14

Given in our hearts as a guarantee of our redemption- 2 Co 1:22; 5:5

-- The Spirit is the Father's insurance that He will deliver as promised

# **D.** the fruit of the spirit...

Developing graces of Christ-like conduct - Ga 5:22-26

Engendering a deepening love for God as Father - Ga 4:6; Ro 8: 15-16

Filling us with hope - Ro 15:13

-- The Spirit is the Father's instrument to bless the Christian

### E. the intercession of the spirit...

Helping us in our weakness, even in our prayers - Ro 8:26

Making intercession for with groanings that cannot be uttered - Ro 8:26-27

-- The Spirit is the Father's interpreter to hear the Christian

### F. the gifts of the spirit

Supernatural gifts for the profiting of the body of Christ and the individual-<u>1Corinthians</u>
<u>12:1</u>

Ministerial leadership gifts for the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry and for the edifying of the body of Christ-**Ephesians 4:11**-
